Academic Hold	Hold Description: The hold is based upon Academic Progression or Program Coordinator request Hold Information: Student will need to review Academic Progression with Program Coordinator. Contact Program Coordinator for more details
Academic Progress	Hold Description: Student has course substitutions or exceptions Hold Information: Your account is under review to determine if substitutions are applicable
Accounts Receivable	Hold Description: Student has minimum of \$10 outstanding and is past due Hold Information: Once a Student has paid the outstanding balance on their account the hold is removed Click on your Student Account to check and pay your fees.
Collections	Hold Description: Student has and outstanding balance and is attached to a Collection Agency for more details Hold Information: Payment must be made to the Collection Agency and Hold will be removed
Advising Hold	The hold is based upon a Program Coordinator request Hold Information: Student will need to review Academic Progression with PC Contact Program Coordinator for more details
Outstanding NSF	Hold Description: Student has outstanding NSF charge on their account Hold Information: Once a Student has paid the outstanding balance on their account NSF charge the hold is removed
Registration Hold	Hold Description: Used for restricting students from registering due to outstanding fees not being paid. Hold Information: Once payment is made the hold will be removed to allow registration which opens on August 5.
