Error Message	Description of the Error	Resolution
Academic Standing prohibits registration	If your standing was Required to Withdraw in your previous term, you standing does not permit registration.	Contact your Program Coordinator. You can find your Program Coordinator (Primary Advisor) on your Student Information menu.
Administrative staff is reviewing your registration records at this time. Please try again later.	A staff member is currently performing registration activity on your record	Try again later and if registration continues to be inaccessible contact the Office of the Registrar. All required courses could not be successfully registered, please check your Academic Progress and ensure you have met all prerequisites of the course you are trying to register for. College Restriction	This course is restricted to students in a specific College (School)	You need to choose courses that are part of your College (School) or contact Program coordinator for assistance.

Duplicates: DUPLICATE CRN	Error appears when registering for two CRNs for the same course in the same term	One of the CRNs must be deleted from your registration for you to continue

Level: LEVEL RESTRICTION	Student's level (calendar type, example Degree, postsecondary) prevents registration	Student must choose courses from the same program level I.e. PS student to choose PS courses, DE (Degree) student to choose Degree courses.
Pre-requisite and Test score: PREQ and TEST SCORE-ERROR	Course based registration: Student lacks the required prerequisite course and/or minimum test score when registering for a course from a course Block based registration: Student may get this error when trying to register for Additional block courses: Student may lack the required prerequisite course and/or minimum test score when registering for a course from a course Click on the CRN (course registration number) displayed as part of the error which has a hyperlink; the student may click to see details on why the student failed the prerequisite check.	Course based registration students: Register for all of your other courses and contact your program coordinator to work on a solution for the courses you require pre-requisites for. Block based registration students: You will not be able to register for your additional block courses, please contact your program coordinator to work on a solution. A SAF (student action form) will be submitted to the Office of the Registrar to be processed after you meet with your Program Coordinator. First semester students: Please ensure you have written your CPT test.

Registration is not available at this time	Registration has not yet been enabled for the term. Student Status prohibits registration	Your student record is currently inactive due to non-attendance or graduation.	You must contact your program coordinator who will submit a SAF requesting a resume studies.
There are no suggested blocks available.	This error indicates that at least one course in each of the available primary registration blocks is closed. If one of the courses in a primary block is closed, the block will not be displayed.	Please contact your Program Coordinator (Primary Advisor) found on the Student Information tab regarding course availability.
Time Conflict: TIME CONFLICT WITH XXXXX	This course has a time conflict with another course on the student's schedule	One CRN must be deleted from your registration schedule.
You are not permitted to search for courses	This error occurs if you attempt to search for courses but you are subject to block registration requirements. Students subject to block registration may only register in approved primary and additional block courses.	Please contact your Program Coordinator if you wish to add a course outside your block or additional block. If your Program coordinator allows you to enroll in the requested course(s), he/she will then submit a SAF (student action form) to the Office of the Registrar for processing.
